

Advertisement for appointment of Vyakhyata Sahayak for Government Colleges 2016-17

Online applications are invited from the eligible candidates for approximately 574 vacant posts of Assistant Professors (Vyakhyata Sahayak) in faculties of Arts, Science, Commerce, Law and Education in Government colleges on 11 months contractual basis with a fixed pay of Rs. 25000/- per month for the academic year 2016-17.

The recruitment process will be carried out as per UGC Regulations 2010 and the notifications of Education Department, Government of Gujarat dated:19th March-2011; 29th June-2011, 7thMay-2012,6th February-2014,4th June-2016.

Eligible candidates can submit their applications online on www.cheguj.com from 09-06-2016 to 18-06-2016 by the following instructions on website.

1. Educational Qualifications:

A. Arts, Commerce, Science and Law faculty subjects:

According to the guidelines of the University Grants Commission-2010, the candidate must have possess minimum 55 % marks in related Subject at post graduate level and must have cleared UGC NET (certificate) or GSLET (certificate) examination.

Candidates from Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Differently Disabled categories of the Gujarat origin will be entitled to a maximum of 5% relaxation at postgraduate level without considering grace marks.

In respect of the candidates who have passed post-graduation before 19-09-1991 and having Ph.D. will get relaxation of 5 % marks.

Candidates with Ph.D. qualification as per University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009, will be exempted from NET/SLET qualification. Such candidates with Ph.D. qualification as per University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009, have to produce a certificate from the competent authority of the respective University in this regard.

B. For Education faculty (B.Ed. Colleges) :

The Qualification is as per University Grants Commission Regulations, 2010.

Minimum 50 % marks at Graduate level in respective subject method, Minimum 50 % marks in Master's degree in the relevant subject and M.Ed. with relevant subject (Minimum 55 % marks in M.Ed. or equivalent grade) and NET/SLET/SET.Candidate should have Minimum Qualification of Certification.

Candidates with Ph.D. qualification as per University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009, will be exempted from NET/SLET qualification. Such candidates with Ph.D. qualification as per University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009, have to produce a certificate from the competent authority of the respective University in this regard.

Candidates from Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Differently Disabled categories of Gujarat origin will be entitled to a maximum of 5% relaxation at postgraduate level in accordance with the UGC Regulation 2009.

2. Age:

2.1 Maximum 40 years for Arts, Commerce and Science faculties.

2.2 Maximum of 40 years for Law faculty.

2.3 Maximum of 37 years for Education faculty.

2.4 Relaxations will be given in the age to the candidates from following categories according to the existing State Government's Norms:

2.4.1 Scheduled Castes / Scheduled Tribes / SEBC (Socially and Economically Backward Class) candidates - 5 Years

2.4.2 Unreserved Women Candidates - 5 years

2.4.3 Women Candidates – 10 years from reserved categories (This relaxation also includes the 05 years' relaxation for women mentioned above)

2.4.4 Differently Disabled candidates- 10 years

2.4.5 All the above relaxation will be available to the candidate's in the age limit of 45 years.

3. Merit calculation

According to the Government Resolution dated 17/06/2009 of Education Department, Government of Gujarat, marks obtained out of 90 merit points will be considered. No test or interview will be conducted. Following pattern will be applied.

Applicant must be Graduate and Post Graduate in the same subject for which he/she applied. Further he/she must have passed NET/SLET in the same subject. Candidates having Ph. D degree in the same subject as UG and PG level are eligible.

Books and Journal for which candidates have claimed merit marks must be published in Prestigious Publication and must have ISBN / ISSN, whichever is applicable. Further at the time of verification candidates will have to produce certificate from the publisher.

Experience of Contractual Recruitment at Government colleges will be considered. Experience at Grant-in Aid Colleges, University Department or Self-Finance Institution as Guest or Visiting Lecturer will not be counted.

Candidate claiming merit marks for University Rank will have to produce certificate stating that he/she stood first at University and not in any subject. Proof of Gold Medal only will not suffice.

4. Remuneration:

Contract Based Vyakhyata Sahayak is entitled to get a fixed pay of

Rs. 25,000 /- per month.

5. Appointment period:

The appointment will be for 11 months and the candidates will be relieved as and when a GPSC candidate is available or a day before ending second term of a college affiliated to the respective university's regular academic year 2016-17, whichever is earlier.

Under no circumstances the appointment of the candidate will be extended after the period of 11 months.

6. Vacant Posts to be filled:

Subject and category wise posts to be filled are as per annexure-1

7. For Reserved Category Candidates

7.1 Subject wise reserved posts for different categories will be as per Annexure -1.

7.2 Candidates of Economically Backward Class have to produce certificate in performa mentioned in the Resolution of 12-05-2016 No: PVS/102016/538/G-4

7.3 Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Differently Disabled candidates of Gujarat origin will be entitled to get relaxation in qualifications as per prevailing norms. Such candidates have to produce original certificates from the competent authority regarding their caste/Tribe/ Physical disability at the time of document verification.

7.4 Candidates from Socially and Educationally Backward Classes have to produce non-creamy layer certificate shown as Annexure-C, in the resolution of Department of Social Justice and Empowerment, dated 06/02/1996.

Candidates from Socially and educationally Backward Classes are entitled to get benefits of reservation only if they are not included in non-creamy layer category.

Please note that married women candidates have to produce such certificate in reference to the income of their parents. If she has produced a certificate of her husband's income, her application will be cancelled.

Such certificate must show the income for the period 01/04/2015 to 31/03/2016 or should have been issued after 01/04/2016.

8. Important instructions for filling the online application form and for the overall recruitment process.

- 8.1 Eligible candidates have to apply online on website www.cheguj.com within the prescribed time limit.
- 8.2 Candidates are requested to study the instructions and advertisement given on website carefully before filling the application form. Online filled application forms by the candidate will be considered as final and no modification can be made or no request from the candidate will be considered.
- 8.3 Application form will not be accepted through Postal and Courier and will be rejected. nor are they to be hand delivered, faxed or emailed to the office.
- 8.4 The candidate will have to register first on website www.cheguj.com. If needed, necessary instructions will be given to the candidates from time to time on his/her e-mail ID. Candidates have to give their own e-mail ID.
- 8.5 On-line application form will open by logging in on website after registration. Application form should be filled up carefully. Correction can be made by the candidates in his/her form before 18/06/2016. No correction or updating can be made after this date. If the candidate makes any mistake in the online application form, his/her application form will not be considered. It is mandatory for every candidate to give his/her mobile number in the application form which should not be changed till the completion of recruitment process.
- 8.6 An amount of Rs 200/- will have to be paid as application fee by the General Category Candidate but According to General Resolution(GR) of State Government's General Administrative Department(GAD), Gandhinagar No:pvs/102016/538/g-4,dated: 12th May, 2016 candidates of Economically Weaker Section will have to provide Proof for exemption from application fees. Socially and Educationally Backward Class (SEBC) category candidates, Schedule Castes, Schedule Tribes and differently-disabled candidates will have to produce relevant certificates at the time of verification. Failing to produce such certificates, application will automatically rejected. Fee once paid will not be refunded.

After filling online form, candidates have to download the printed copy of Bank-challan and deposit application fee through challan at any branch of Dena Bank on or before 16.00 hours (4.00 p.m.) of Dt: 22/06/2016.

Candidate has to retain one copy (Candidate's copy) of the challan with Transaction Identity provided by Bank.

Candidates can pay application form fee online through NEFT by using following information. Application of such candidates will be confirmed only after 25 hours of paying online fees on their reference Id.

Candidates have to log in again using their USER ID and PASSWORD on **www.cheguj.com** website after one day and submit transaction ID of paying fees by challan, so that system can verify and display the acceptance of online application of the candidate. If the instruction of the acceptance of the form does not appear on the screen then it is considered that application form has not been submitted and such application will not be considered further.

Transaction ID data in the system provided by the bank will be updated at 12:00 noon during working days so that system can verify by entering transaction ID after 25 hours of paying fees.

Candidates claiming candidateship under reserve posts are exempted from paying form fees, will have to confirm their application. Application which are not confirms by the candidates till last date of filling application, will be rejected.

- 8.7 Candidates have to take a print of their application form by downloading from the website after applying online and have to keep it with them to produce whenever asked.
- 8.8 Necessary instructions related to the contractual based *Vyakhyata Sahayak* will be available on website from time to time.
- 8.9 The names of the short listed candidates (Subject and category wise)

will be displayed on **www.cheguj.com**.

- 8.10 Short listed candidates will have to log in on the website and download call letter for their certificates / documents verification. Candidates have to remain present for document verification on the date and time as mentioned in the call letter on their own expense. If a candidate fails to remain present on given time and date, his/her right of appointment will be cancelled.

Verification of certificates and documents will be done Knowledge Consortium of Gujarat (K.C.G.),Pragnapuram,L.D.College Campus, Navrangpura, Ahmedabad, Gujarat.

- 8.11 At the time of verification of certificates of candidates, if their merit rank gets reduced and if the reduced marks are less than the cut-off marks for respective subject and category, then college will not be allotted to such candidate during that round.
- 8.12 Candidate who got verified their certificates and documents and having merit marks greater than the cut off marks of shortlisted candidates in the respective subject/category will be allotted a college by the system on the basis of their merit marks and their preference order of college. Candidates can download their appointment letter by logging on **www.cheguj.com**
- 8.13 After receiving appointment letters, candidates have to join and report to the allotted college within the specified time, failing which his/her appointment letter will be automatically cancelled.

No request for change of college/ place will be considered in any circumstance.

- 8.14 Candidates have to produce all original certificates and documents related to eligibility and qualification at the time of document verification.
- 8.15 Disciplinary action will be taken against the candidate who tries to produce forged/bogus/invalid documents or where original documents are found to have been tampered.
- 8.16 Candidates who submit false / incorrect/ wrong information in the online application will be disqualified.

If the information given by the candidate is found to be false / incorrect / wrong or erroneous then he/she will be disqualified either at the time of recruitment or at any subsequent stage during service in future and no claim for service in this regard will be considered.

- 8.17 Candidates have to bring and produce a valid photo identity proof at the time of document verification.
- 8.18 Candidates must not contact any person who is associated with recruitment process. Application of the candidate who are found to being pressure in any form or indulge in disturbing the recruitment process will not be considered.
- 8.19 Office of the Commissioner of Higher Education gives equal opportunity to all and encourages women candidates to apply.
